Phonological Awareness: (Pre-k–1st) Ways you can help your child hear sounds. These are **very important** early reading skills!

Sight Words: (Pre-k–2nd) Ways you can help your child memorize words that can't be sounded out.

Spelling: (Kindergarten–5th) Ways you can help your child hear individual sounds within a word and spell one sound at a time.

Fluency: (2nd–5th) Ways you can help your child read with proper expression.

During Reading Strategies (2nd–5th) Ways you can help your child fix reading errors and make sure he/she understands what he/she read.

Writing About What You Read (2nd–5th) Ways you can help your child write about what he/she read.
